

Expanding Your Horizons (EYH) is a one-day conference for 7th–9th grade girls. The 7th & 8th grade girls each participate in three workshops organized by Cornell students and faculty, while 9th grade girls participate in two extended workshops. The goals of the conference are to stimulate the participants' interest in math and science through these hands-on activities, to provide them with female scientist role models, and to foster awareness of opportunities in math and science-related careers.

Although the focus of the EYH conference is to provide hands-on learning experiences for girls, we also organize a special session for accompanying adults to give them information on educational and career opportunities involving science, math, and engineering.

Other highlights of EYH include a keynote speech by a prominent woman scientist and a display of science books, resources, and games that participants and their parents can access throughout the day.

Lottery System

We are using a lottery system again in 2017 to determine who can attend EYH. Girls will be able to sign up for the EYH lottery online February 20-24. We will announce the lottery results on February 27. If you are selected for EYH, we will give you instructions for completing your registration.

There will be one lottery for individuals, and another lottery for groups of 2 to 25 girls. Spaces in the conference will be split between the individual and group lotteries in proportion to the number of entrants, so there is no advantage to entering one lottery vs. the other. Each girl can only be entered in one of the lotteries. You will need the following information to enter a girl in the EYH lottery: her name, home address, grade level, ethnicity, and the number of times she has attended EYH in the past.

EYH registration is now online-only; we are no longer accepting paper registration forms. If this is a hardship for you, please contact us and we will work with you to complete your lottery entry and registration.

Conference Fees

There is no fee to enter the registration lottery. If you are selected to attend EYH, the registration fee is \$20 per student and is non-refundable.

Extra Credit

Any student of Mr. Flick's who is selected to go *and* who attends the EYH event will receive 15 points of extra credit for that marking period.
